

How to Encrypt RFC Password?

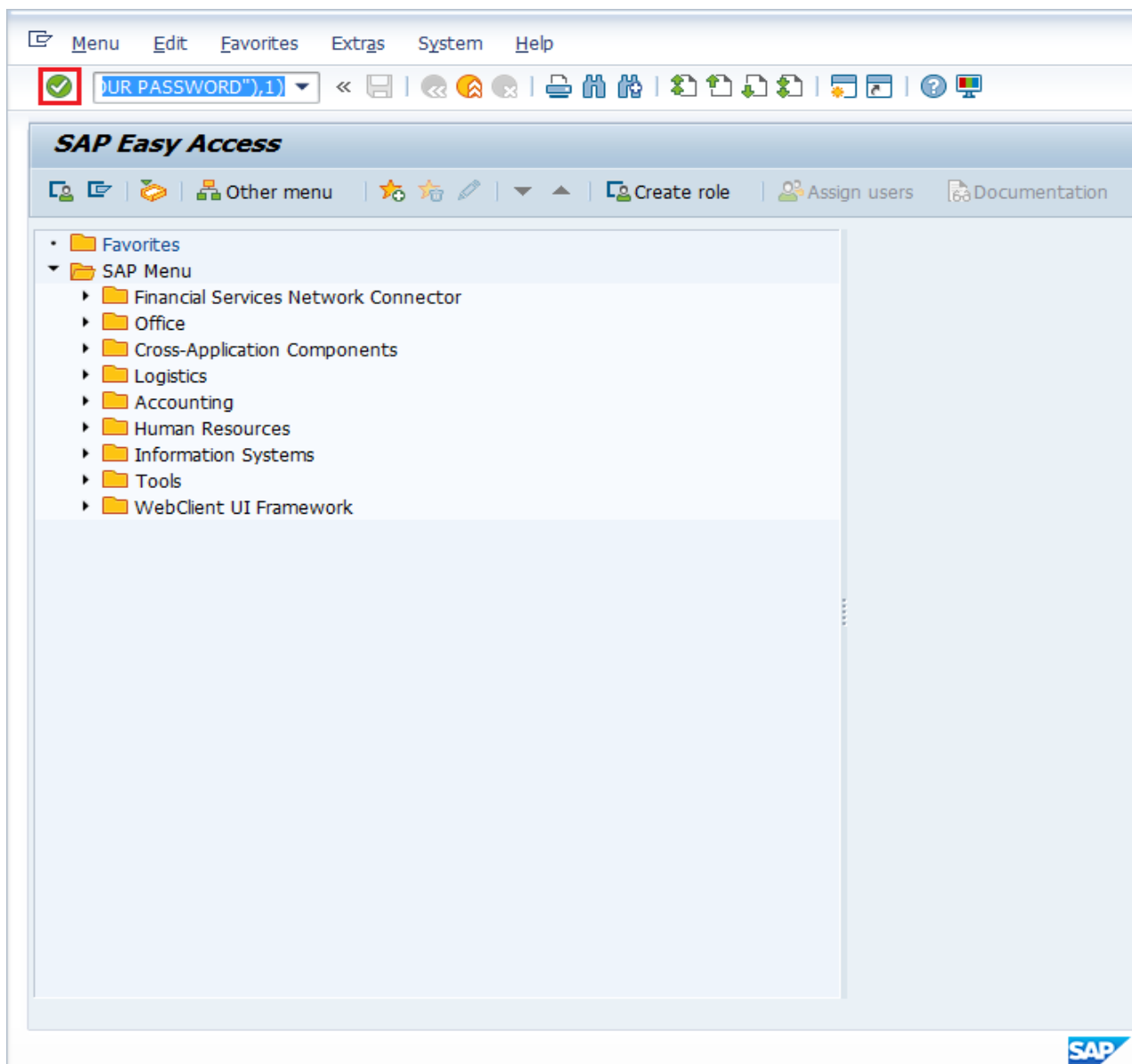
Purpose:

Please follow the Steps Below:

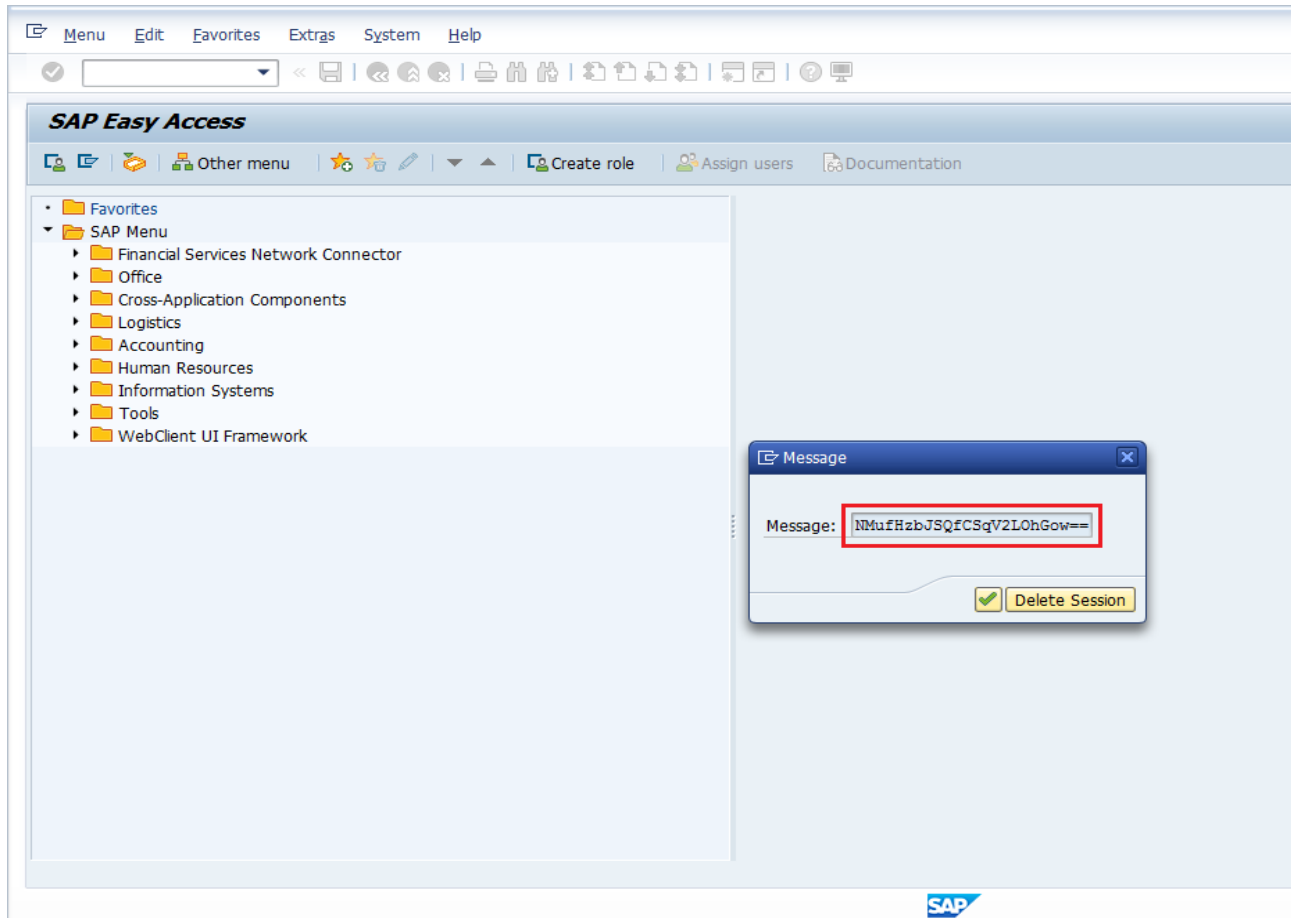
Step-1:

Enter /wsmessage(encrypt("YOUR PASSWORD"),1) on SAP Screen (in the tcode box) and hit enter or click on Enter Button as Shown.



Step-2:

You will get the “Message” Pop-up Window, Copy the Encrypted Password which is there in the “Message:” Field.



Step-3:

Put the Copied Encrypted Password in the “guixt.sjs” file as shown below.
