

Changing F4 Help Display Settings in Liquid UI Client


Purpose: Below Article would help in changing the F4 help display options.






Step-2: On the SAP Easy Access Screen at the top right corner of the screen, tap on the Settings Icon for iOS and More Option if it is Android.






Step-3: Under the System Menu Tap on Help.






Step-4: Tap on Settings...






Step-5: On the Screen Personal Settings for User, tap on the F4 Help Tab.




Step-6: Select the Radio Button Dialog(Modal) / System defaults and Tap on the Continue tick mark button.


